Nebraska Community Colleges offering Statewide Early Childhood Courses	Wayne State College
Associate of Applied Science Early Childhood	Early Childhood Inclusive

This program-to-program transfer agreement between Nebraska Community Colleges and the Wayne State College (WSC), Department of Education, Early Childhood Inclusive major is designed to facilitate transfer among institutions. Students may receive at least **57 credits of program-specific coursework** pending careful selection of community college courses to meet the needs of WSC requirements. Additional courses may be transferred, up to a total of 66 credits, if a community college has articulation agreements beyond this statewide agreement. This agreement does not guarantee admission to WSC, the Teacher Education Program, or the Early Childhood Inclusive major. Students must apply and meet specific requirements for admission to the college and major.

This agreement consists of program courses and General Studies courses.
