About the Internship:

The Quilting Leadership Internship provides students with hands-on experience supporting quilting instruction and program leadership. Interns will assist with sewing and quilting activities while developing technical skills, leadership abilities, and instructional experience in a structured learning environment.

Key Responsibilities:

- Assist with quilting and sewing activities during scheduled sessions
- Demonstrate knowledge of sewing machines, sewing terminology, and sewing tools
- Support the proper use, care, and maintenance of quilting and sewing equipment
- Provide guidance and assistance to participants as needed

Who Should Apply:

- Full-time or half-time, degree-seeking student
- In good academic standing (minimum 2.0 GPA and 67% completion rate)
- Familiarity with sewing machines and basic sewing techniques
- Interest in leadership and working with others in a learning environment
- Reliable, motivated, and able to communicate effectively
